

Mobil Serv[™] Lubricant Analysis – Scanner setup

The purpose of this document is to provide instructions to setup your new Mobil Serv Lubricant Analysis QR/barcode scanner if necessary. Skip this step if you are using an English keyboard language.

Note: If your scanner does not work properly and enters a text string that the Mobil Serv application cannot process, you may want to follow the steps below.

Step	Action	Example. Ref
1	Connect the QR/barcode scanner to the USB port of your PC	
2	The scanner should light up or make a sound that goes "beep"	7
3	To allow the use of a non-US English language keyboard, the QR/barcode scanner settings have to be changed. 4b	 Scan the numeric bar code(s) of the selected country by refering to the Programming Chart below For example: If the selected country is Russia, which is "26" on the programming chart. Scan the numeric bar code "2" followed by the numberic bar code "6" 	
4c	 Scan the Save bar code to complete the program of the keyboard 	Save
